



## Introducing the Health Care Cost Estimator

Compare treatment costs before your visit

Medical treatment costs can vary widely among doctors and facilities. They also play a part in helping you decide where to get treatment. HAP has made the process easy with our new online tool – the Health Care Cost Estimator. It gives you estimated prices on doctor visits and procedures up front, to help you make a more informed decision on where to get care.

The Health Care Cost Estimator:

- Lets you shop for treatment options, compare prices and show where you can save
- Gives you the average cost of treatment options in your area
- Shows your personal out-of-pocket costs for a treatment
- Educates you on some of the tests, treatments and medications that may be part of your overall treatment plan

The Health Care Cost Estimator is available to HAP members, with the exception of those with Medicare. Always check with your doctor and HAP on preauthorization and network requirements before making an appointment. Some providers may display that are not part of your network. If you have a spouse or dependent on your HAP plan over age 18, you will not be able to view that person's information.

## Health Care Cost Estimator home screen

1. **Get Estimates for Healthcare Costs:** Search for a treatment, procedure or service (e.g., lipid panel, X-ray, office visit, surgery).
2. **Browse Medical Conditions:** Here's where you can search by specific criteria. For example, type of treatment or service, who is getting treatment or an area of the body.
3. **Estimate For:** You can search for yourself or dependents under 18 who are on your policy.\*
4. **Starting Location:** Your home address will appear here automatically. Medical treatment locations are based on the starting location.
5. **Change Location:** Get an estimate for a different location.
