In an effort to provide positive human services work experience, reduce stigma, widen horizons, and enrich the environment for individuals served, GHS would like to offer paid internships to a select number of students this summer.* You must be interested in a career in the behavioral health field; e.g., Social Work, Counseling, Psychology, Health Education, Health, or have an interest in a field that supports health care such as Marketing, Health Care Administration, or IT. You must be 18 by June 3, 2024 and currently be enrolled in a college or university. You must have achieved at least sophomore status by June 3, 2024. (Applicants who graduated college in 2023 or 2024 will also be considered). ***Please note: in addition to shadowing in various behavioral health programs throughout the agency, our GTF interns regularly help out with a variety of agency activities, including the GHS Community Garden (weekly), Consumer Dance, Consumer Picnic, Family Fun Day, GCHC events, etc.

Your application must include the following:

- A cover letter that includes your full name, address, phone number, and email address. Indicate whether you are related to any current or former GHS employee.
- A résumé showing all prior and current work experience including previous GHS internships. Returning students *may* be considered, depending on the number of qualified applicants.
- A double-spaced, typed essay (limited to two pages with one-inch margins and no more than 500 words) addressing your specific interest in the behavioral health field <u>and</u> how a summer internship at GHS will help to advance your career goals.
- An <u>OFFICIAL</u> college transcript (bearing the college seal). This can be mailed or sent electronically directly from the university. **Unofficial documents will not be accepted.**
- A letter of recommendation by a professor or (college) academic counselor. The letter should be in a signed, sealed envelope or emailed to nkirsh@genhs.org directly from the professor or counselor.

If selected you are expected to attend GHS orientation from 8am - 5pm on Monday, June 3, 2024.

Selected applicants will be notified by phone; all others will be notified by U.S. Mail or email.
