The GHS Mobile Crisis Team provides mobile crisis stabilization services at no cost, 7 days a week, 24 hours a day to all children, youth, and young adults who reside in Genesee County.

Reasons to call GHS:

- If you feel your child/youth is in a crisis
- The child/youth may hurt themselves or others
- The child is experiencing overwhelming confusion, anger, or emotional unresponsiveness
- If you feel you cannot independently manage the situation

If you aren't sure if the Mobile Crisis Team is needed, give us a call and we can help to explore options.

What happens when the GHS Mobile Crisis Team is called?

The team will provide on site intervention. Their main focus is to help to de-escalate the situation and determine the next best steps for you and your family.
